In 2026, Bulawayo – The City of Kings – will host a historic expression of Christian unity:
Stadium Worship & The One Story Media Campaign.

This initiative brings churches across denominations together to lift up one name – Jesus – through worship, prayer, and a renewed message of hope for the city.

A PROVEN HISTORY OF UNITY Harare 2017 – 2018: A Model of Impact

In 2017 and 2018, something remarkable happened in Harare:

Churches laid down their differences.
Leaders chose honour.
Young people rallied around the name of Jesus.

The results:

- Over **200 churches united** across denominations
- **18,000 people** gathered at Glamis Arena
- Over **6 million** people engaged via Radio & TV
- Three months of coordinated media engagement
- Citywide prayer meetings across multiple venues
- Relationships built between church leaders that remain strong today

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WHY BULAWAYO 2026?

Bulawayo is not just another city. It is:

- A historic spiritual and cultural center
- A crossroads of influence
- A city marked by resilience
- A city carrying both deep pain and deep promise
- A city with a prophetic future

Through economic hardship and national pressure, the people of Bulawayo have remained strong. There is a quiet strength here. A dignity. A hunger for hope.

We believe this is a defining moment for the City of Kings.

THE TWO CORE EXPRESSIONS IN 2026

1. Stadium Worship (One City, One Voice, One Name.)

A united afternoon and evening of worship and prayer featuring:

- One interchanging united band and choir
- Worshippers from multiple churches
- No logos. No introductions. No platform personalities
- A visible expression of Psalm 133 unity

Unity will not just be seen on stage — it will be formed in prayer rooms, rehearsals and in cross church collaboration

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2. The One Story Media Campaign

A multi-month media initiative highlighting:

- The history of Christianity in this province
- Jesus & hope in sports
- Jesus & hope in business and the marketplace
- Jesus & hope in the youth of this region
- A renewed vision for Bulawayo's future

Through radio, television, social media, and public conversations, we aim to shift the narrative of the city toward hope

CORE GOALS FOR BULAWAYO 2026

- See souls reached for Jesus
- Rekindle revival in young people
- Strengthen unity across churches
- Release hope-filled, high quality media
- Model excellence, creativity, and integrity
- Build authentic relationships between leaders
- Capture and document this expression of unity

1. Honour First

We begin face-to-face.

We honor what God is already doing in Bulawayo.

2. A Collective Vision

We unite around Christ and Kingdom purpose – not minor theological differences.

The vision is bigger than any one stream.

3. Remove Financial Barriers

There is no "pay to play."

A church contributing \$10 and a church contributing \$10,000 carry equal voice and value.

4. Only One Name

No brands.

No personalities

No agendas

Jesus at the centre.

5. A "We Movement"

This is not owned by one ministry

This is the collective Church of Bulawayo
